

St. Joseph Medical Center Stained Glass Window Ornaments

In commemoration of the 135th Anniversary of the August 1873 founding of St. Joseph Medical Center, the St. Joseph Medical Center Auxiliary has presented a series of ornaments replicating the nine stained glass windows housed in the Bern Township Medical Center.

The stained glass windows of St. Joe's reflect our mission of spirituality, compassion, caring and giving. From their original home in the chapel at 12th and Walnut Streets to their new home in the Bern Campus, they have radiated serenity, comfort and inspiration.

These collectible ornaments, measuring 2" wide by 3.5" high, are custom-made of solid brass. The images of our stained glass windows are reproduced in rich, colorful detail. Each ornament is packaged in a handsome gift box with an insert card containing a brief history of the window, making the ornaments perfect for holiday and special occasion giving or for creating your own personal collection.

The first ornament in a series of nine, *Jesus' Blessing*, was released in August 2008. Over the past three years, eight additional ornaments have been released to complete the series. Limited quantities of all nine ornaments currently remain available for purchase.

The cost per ornament is \$20. For an additional charge of \$3.25 for shipping and handling, ornaments can be mailed to you or to the recipient of your choice. Net proceeds from the sale of each ornament will support St. Joseph Medical Center.
